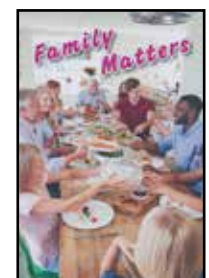
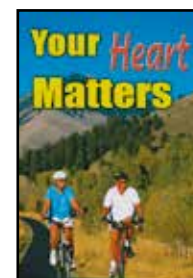
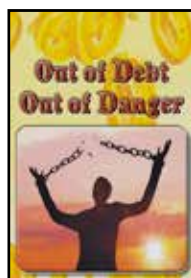
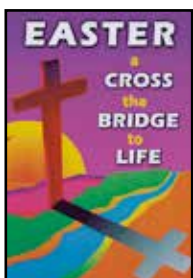
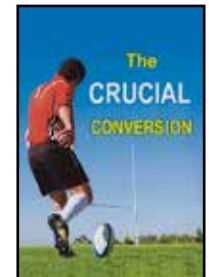
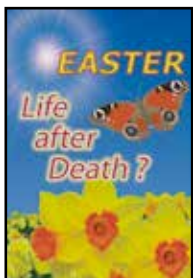
Barry asked for these, his final words, to be read out at the conclusion of his thanksgiving service.

'Thank you so much for coming along today to share in the praise and thanksgiving to our glorious God, for all His unfailing love towards me.

But in this a form of postscript to my life, I want to turn the focus away from me and on to you instead, and especially if you haven't become a true Christian.

If you sense the risen Lord Jesus Christ speaking to your heart please, please don't hold back. He'll help you to turn away from all you know to be wrong in your life. And in receiving Him by His Spirit into your life He'll give you a completely new start, with the desire and power to live a new lifestyle, pleasing to Him. But remember, no decision is a No decision and if we neglect, ignore or reject Him in this world it will mean rejection for us in the next. So please reach out to Him with an open heart and mind, and you'll find He is already reaching out to you in love, forgiveness and reconciliation.

And finally, remember, if there is such a thing as a heavenly café, then it would be a great pleasure to meet you there and buy you your first bacon roll!'



His words declare his whole manner of life and his heart for those who don't know the Lord Jesus as Saviour. The thanksgiving service, attended by hundreds, demonstrated the number of people whose lives were positively impacted by knowing him.

His favourite verse must have been 2Cor. 5:17 '...if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!' He knew the change in his own life and wanted everyone else to have the same experience. 2Cor 5:14 says 'For Christ's love compels us' – not our love for Him but a recognition of God's far exceeding love for each of us. That same love 'compels' each of us as well. So, for Barry his service has achieved 'an eternal glory that far outweighs' all the difficulties of this life (2Cor 4:17). Two truly wonderful chapters to encourage all of us to follow Barry's example.
