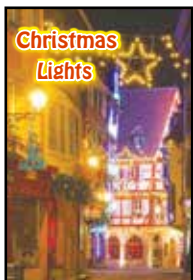
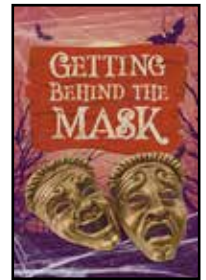
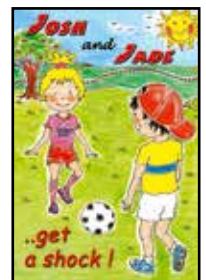


# News Prayer Praise

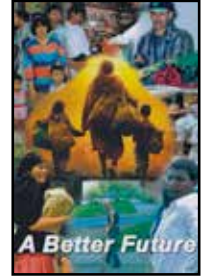

We are encouraged when we hear of how the leaflets are being used, the conversations that are held, and rejoice when we hear of some coming to know Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour. Do send us your comments.

Here are some comments received since the last newsletter.

Cumbria Gospel Outreach were reaching out again at Appleby Gypsy Fair. There were many good conversations held. They also have a regular stall at Keswick Market and have been active at shows at Appleby, Penrith, West Moreland and others. 'As a general note, once again the Tract, Family Matters', is rarely refused. Young mothers in particular seem to appreciate, especially when an activity Tract in the Josh & Jade series accompanies and offers some family participation later in the day.'

Pray for all who have heard or read the gospel message as well as those who give out the literature.

Report from a Christian with a heart for people. 'We're coming to the end of our trip in Canada. It's such a lovely country but so much more is the joy of sharing "Finding your way in Scotland" leaflets, and amazingly have just 2 bundles after squeezing in 2000 leaflets in luggage. The leaflet has been so well received most folks express their delight in receiving one - a tremendous God given opportunity to daily sow the seed and the majority resulted in conversations. I couldn't begin to tell of the people and conversations we had with all walks of life -Asians, Jews, Hutterites, Nuns, hotel and restaurant staff, homeless, Border control, police, firemen, film crews, Mayors, tourists and locals as well as resulting in fellowship with many lovely Christians. Pray that the seed will fall into good ground for His Glory.'

It has been encouraging to provide leaflets for 3 people aged over 90 in different parts of the UK who still have a heart to reach out to the lost around them. No-one is too old or too young to hand out a leaflet.

From Berkshire. '42 labourers went to give out the leaflets ... there were testimonies of people putting their trust in Christ.'

Leaflets were also distributed at shows across the UK, the National Ploughing Championships in Ireland and the Golf Open at Troon as well as at other events.

## TELit Tips

There are other events such as Halloween and Remembrance Day for which there are good leaflets you can use to reach out to others. As always they use a subject that the reader is interested in to share the gospel. See the cover pictures around the edge of the newsletter.

Table or Wall Dispensers, wallets and pocket wallets are still available. Carry a few leaflets in your pocket to give out as the opportunity arises. Encourage your friends to do it as well.

Other ideas include getting a special leaflet for your church or get a leaflet for your area with local pictures and details of scenic or historical interest. Some have been done recently.

Leaflets can be bought through Day One as well if you are buying other Christian literature at the same time. They may be available at your local Christian retailer too.

Get printed on the leaflets your invitations to services both special and weekly, or that can be watched online and get them distributed by a local leaflet distributor or Royal Mail.

Could you be a TELit champion and help everyone in your church to give out even one a week? How many people could then get the message of salvation.

As the cost of everything has hugely increased we are unable to absorb the rises any longer. From January the price will increase back to its 1997 level. This is the first increase since 1997 and in 2018 the leaflets were even reduced in price.

Royal Mail prices have also increased and we have reduced the number of mail shots to 2. If you let us have your email we will provide an updated newsletter once or twice a year. If you do not want these newsletters please let us know. Overall, parcel carriage prices have been reduced by over 30% since 2015.
