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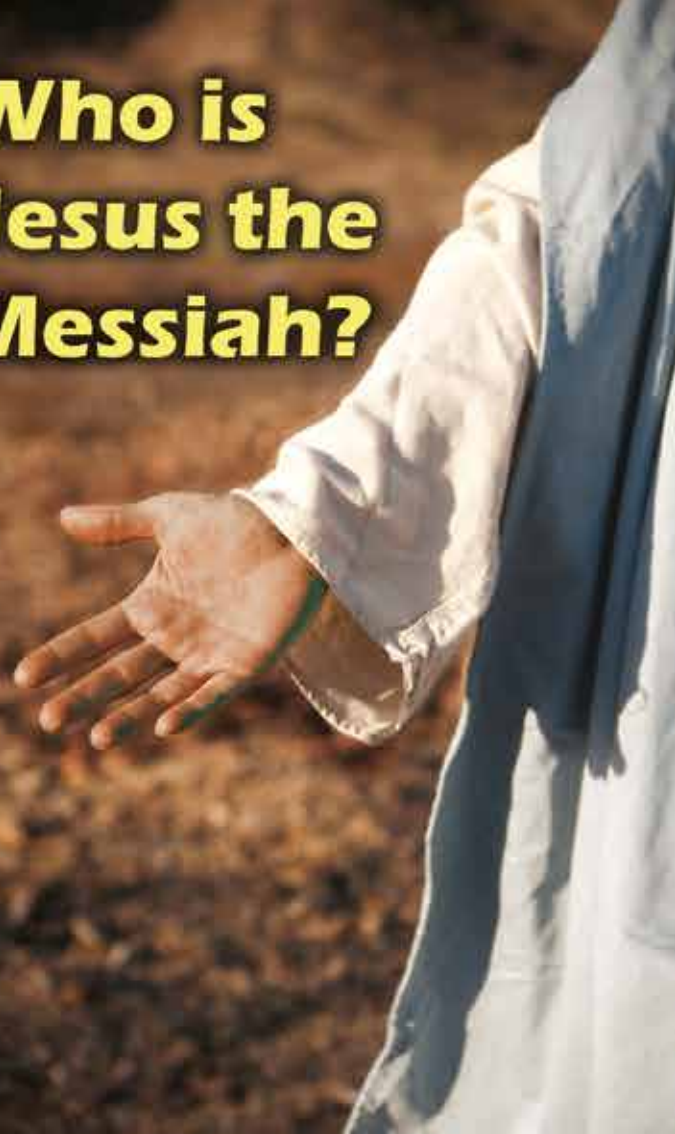
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# Who is Jesus the Messiah?



## Born of a Virgin

The way Jesus was born was a sign that He is utterly unique. 700 years before his birth the great prophet Isaiah said...

*"The virgin shall conceive and give birth to a son, and his name shall be Immanuel (God with us)."*

Isaiah 7:14

Mary, the mother of Jesus, was engaged to be married when the angel Gabriel appeared and told her she would have a son. She protested this was impossible, but in the New Testament (Holy Injil) we read that the angel replied...

*"The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you."*

Luke 1:35

Who else was ever born of a virgin?

## Miracle Worker

Jesus performed more amazing miracles than any prophet or apostle. These were signs that He was the saviour sent from God. We are told...

*"The blind receive sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and good news is proclaimed to the poor."*

Luke 7:22

Once, he came to the grave of his friend Lazarus four days after he had died. He shouted in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out." Lazarus walked out of his grave, and many people believed that Jesus was the saviour that God had promised. He said...

*"I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; and whoever lives by believing in me will never die."*

John 11:25



# Spirit of God

Jesus was able to do these miracles by the power of the Spirit of God. He was filled with the power of the Spirit more than any other man. When he was baptised by John the Baptist (Prophet Yahya) the Spirit of God came down and landed on him like a dove, and a voice from heaven said...

*“This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased.”*

Matthew 3:17

He was not a son of God in a physical sense, which would be a blasphemous idea. He was the spiritual Son of God, perfectly obedient to his heavenly Father.

God was pleased with Jesus, because He was perfect and sinless. He was the only man who never had to ask God for forgiveness!

# Word of God

Jesus is the Word of God.

*“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God ...  
The Word became flesh and dwelt among us...  
full of grace and truth.”*

John 1:1,14

God reveals Himself to us through His Word. Many prophets brought a word from God, to the people of their time. God inspired men to record His word in holy books, which still speak to us today.

However, the perfect revelation was when the Word became a man, that we could see, touch and have a relationship with. Only in Jesus’ perfect life, revolutionary teaching, mighty miracles, and acts of compassion can we see the full revelation of God’s holiness, truth, power and love.

# Lamb of God

When John the Baptist (Prophet Yahya) first saw Jesus he cried out...

*“Look, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!”*

John 1:29

When Prophet Abraham took his son up the mountain to offer him as a sacrifice, God sent a lamb to take his place. The sacrifice dies in the place of another.

Jesus was the great sacrifice God sent to die in our place. We should die as the punishment for our sins, but Jesus died on the cross in our place. His death finally and fully secured our salvation.

*“The Son of Man (Jesus) came to give his life as a ransom for many.”*

Mark 10:45

# Receive the Gift

God has given us the greatest gift of all, by sending His perfect Son as the sacrifice for our sins.

In response, we must receive that gift with gratitude, by leaving our sins and following Jesus as our Lord.
