Then he proved he spoke the real truth because after he died he came back to life.

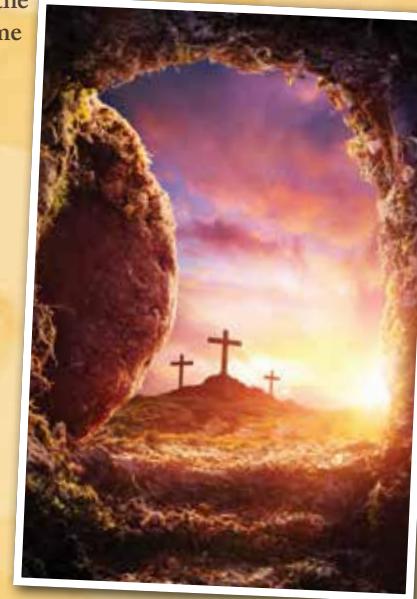
Would getting permanent life be the pivotal event in your life?

Did Jesus really exist?

Jesus was a real person who claimed to be God and the people of his day recognised that he was claiming to be God.

If he was God, is there evidence?

Yes. He was able to perform instantaneous miracles which went beyond the laws of nature, proving that he was the one who made the laws and therefore everything in the first place.

These facts were recorded by multiple people with all sorts of backgrounds in records which can be demonstrated to have the highest reliability. History records that he repeatedly said that he came to die and he did.

It was a most awful death, –nailed to a wooden cross with everyone looking on.

However, since it is impossible for everything to have come from nothing, including life, our existence proves God is alive today.

But why did God take on the form of his creation and why did Jesus die?

Did Jesus really die?

Recorded medical facts showed that he was dead. Here is what one of the eye witnesses recorded.

But when they came to Jesus and found that he was already dead, they did not break his legs. Instead, one of the soldiers pierced Jesus' side with a spear, bringing a sudden flow of blood and water. The man who saw it has given testimony, and his testimony is true. He knows that he tells the truth, and he testifies so that you also may believe.

John 19 33-35



The people who buried him wrapped him in cloth and put him in a tomb from which he rose on the third day. It is recorded that over 500 people saw him, and many saw him eat and touched him.
