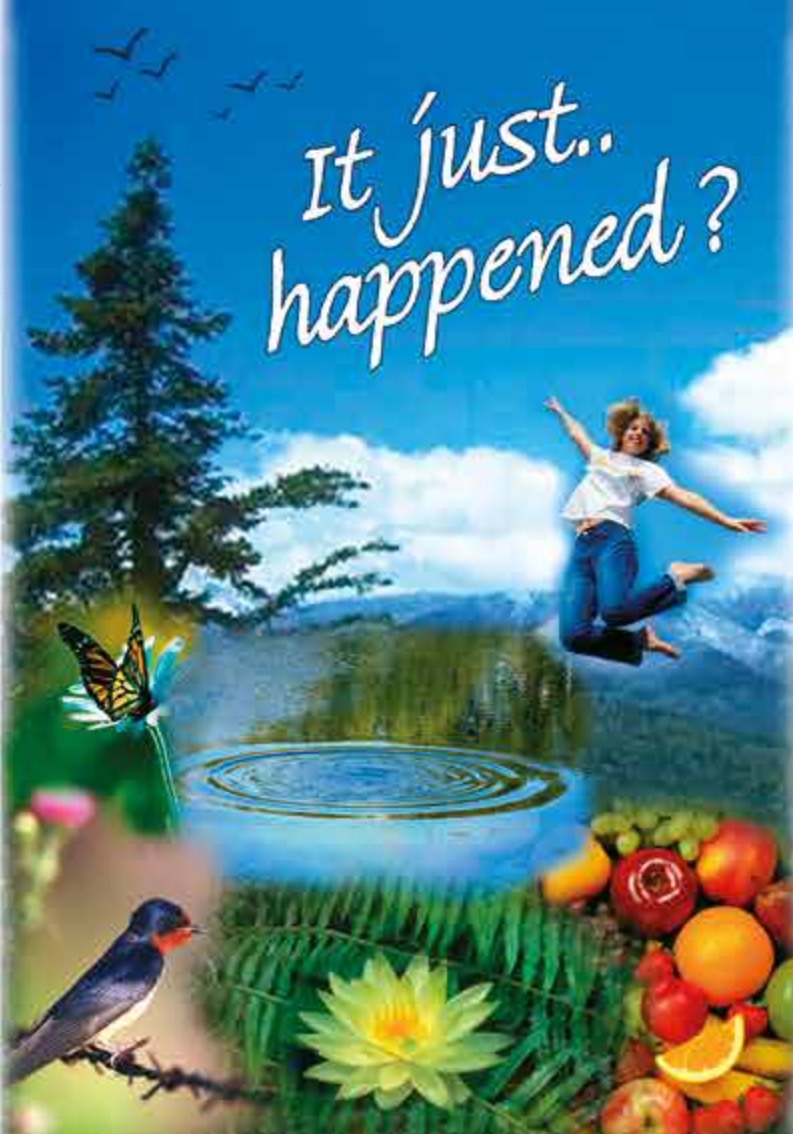

Love and Mercy
