Following Him can cost more than anything... except not following Him...

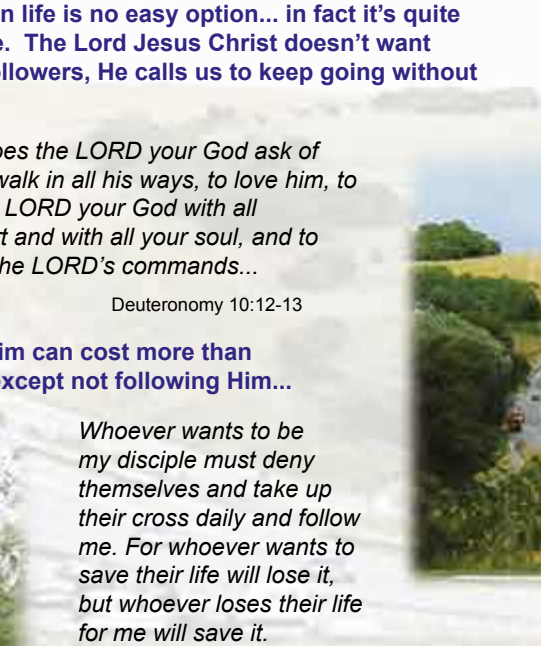
