Mark 7:6,7

Jesus didn't say, "Follow a religion." He said,

Follow Me.

Matthew 16:24



The Big Question What If There's More?

Life can be good, but it's also full of struggles, disappointments, and questions. Why do we feel a deep need for love, purpose, and hope? Why do we wrestle with guilt, knowing we've done things we regret? These questions don't go away just because someone isn't religious.

Jesus came because the biggest problem in our lives isn't a lack of religion—it's that we are separated from God by the way we live. The Bible says,

All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

Romans 3:23



That's not about breaking religious rules; it's about how our choices, pride, and selfishness keep us from the God who created us.

But your iniquities have separated you from your God; your sins have hidden His face from you, so that He will not hear.

Isaiah 59:2

Surely the one who made us knows how best we should live!

Jesus Came to Bring Life, Not Religion

The good news is that God didn't leave us to figure things out on our own. Jesus entered the world to restore what was broken. He didn't just teach good morals—He lived a perfect life, healed the broken, and ultimately, He died on the cross in our place. Not as a religious ritual, but as a rescue mission.

God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 5:8

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

John 3:16

Then He rose from the dead, proving that He has power over sin and death.



A Real Choice, Not a Religious One

The message of Jesus isn't about "becoming religious." It's about being honest about our need for Him.

Jesus said,

I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me

John 14:6

That's not a call to join a religion—it's a personal invitation to know Him.

If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

Romans 10:9

You can have this close relationship with Him!



What Will You Do With Jesus?

You don't have to be religious to see that life is short and eternity is real. Jesus offers forgiveness, hope, and eternal life—not through rituals, but through trusting in Him. The Bible says,

To all who did receive Him, to those who believed in His name, He gave the right to become children of God

John 1:12

Knowing Him will change your life and your lifestyle, and who knows when the opportunity will pass.

God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you." So we say with confidence, "The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid."
