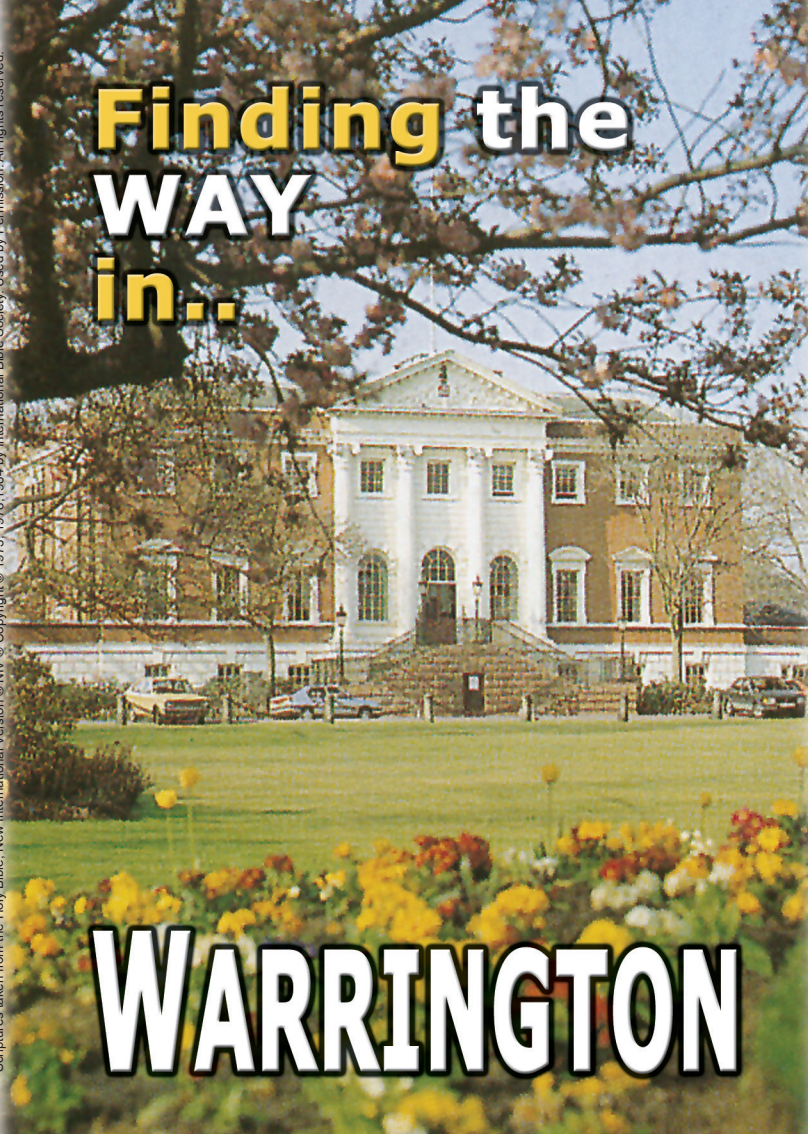

Towering above the town is the 281 ft spire belonging to the Parish Church of St Elphin, the oldest building in Warrington. Founded in the 7th century and mentioned in the Domesday Book in 1086, the church has a long and distinguished history.
